During the MSN-PMHNP program the student must complete the first 25 hours of study at Marshall University: then transfer to Shenandoah University to complete the remaining 29 credit hours of specialty psychiatric mental health courses. The student should complete the courses and not exceed 7 calendar years from the date of first-class enrollment.
