

14TH ANNUAL NATIONAL JURIED EXHIBITION

Prospectus

Marshall University's School of Art & Design is pleased to invite artists to submit entries for the 14th Annual National Juried Exhibition. Accepted works will be exhibited at the Charles W. and Norma C. Carroll Gallery located in the Visual Arts Center in Huntington, West Virginia, from March 10 to April 10, 2025.

ELIGIBILITY

- To be eligible for the exhibition, artists must be 18 years of age or older and must maintain a permanent residence in the U.S. Exceptions are made for students and military personnel with U.S. resident status.
- Artwork previously displayed in Marshall University's art galleries will not be considered.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Artists may submit up to three artworks.
- All entries must be submitted using the online entry form.
- Entry fees must be paid to be considered for the jurying process.

ENTRY FEE General Public: \$30 for up to three entries

Marshall University students: \$15 for up to three entries

JURYING PROCESS

Jurying will take place January 6 through 17, 2025 and will be based on the digital images submitted by entrants. This year's juror is Rebecca Ness, a painter currently living and working in Brooklyn, New York. Ness received her MFA from the Yale School of Art and her BFA from Boston University. She has held solo exhibitions in New York, Paris, London, Los Angeles, Cologne, Germany, and Seoul, Korea and has participated in recent group exhibitions at the SCAD Museum of Art in Savannah, Georgia and Akron Art Museum in Akron, Ohio.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- By submitting an entry to this exhibition, the artist agrees to all conditions outlined in this prospectus.
- Accepted works may not be withdrawn before the exhibition closes.
- The School of Art & Design reserves the right to refuse any entry if, upon arrival, the work is found to be unacceptable or significantly different from the submitted representation.
- All accepted works must be display-ready.

INSURANCE & LIABILITY

The School of Art & Design will take every precaution to safeguard loans in its possession; however, its liability to lenders is limited. Artists whose work is accepted will receive an Art Loan Agreement form detailing any liability assigned to Marshall University. This form must be signed and returned to the Gallery Director by all participating artists before the exhibition begins.

SHIPPING & DELIVERY

The artist is responsible for all delivery costs and for insuring their artwork while it is in transit to and from the gallery.
