MS in Health Informatics Program Ranked #3



The Lewis College of Business, MS in Health Informatics Program was just ranked #3 on the list of the Top 39 Master's in Health Informatics Degree Programs from Intelligent. This list evaluates graduate programs in health informatics that prepare students for healthcare roles such as service managers, information technicians, and medical information officers. Degree options include Master of Science in Health Care Informatics, Health Informatics, Medical Informatics, and Biomedical Informatics. Programs offer on-campus, in-person, and

hybrid learning.

Accreditation plays a pivotal role in the evaluation process. Programs recognized by national bodies like the Commission on Accreditation for Health Informatics and Information Management Education (CAHIIM) and regional accreditors such as the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) are given higher priority.

By 2029, 133,000 jobs will be created in healthcare - specifically health information technology. Marshall's program was recognized for its Outstanding Practicum program.

MS Health Informatics Student wins Bugbee-Falk Book Award

of Business, won the 2023 Bugbee-Falk Book Award from AUPHA for his academic excellence.
