READING TIPS

Read every day and establish a routine

Let your child hold and explore the book

Read the same book multiple times

Use different voices and sounds while reading

Point to and name objects on the page

READ ALOUD

Before Reading- Show your child the front cover of the book and share your prediction on what you think the book might be about.

During Reading- As you read, make sure to turn the pages slowly and give your child time to gaze at the illustrations.

After Reading- Revisit the pages and point out and name all of the different colors you see.

BOOK ACTIVITIES

- Peek-a-boo- Use a blanket or stuffed toy to cover your face and play peek-a-boo with your child.
- Nursery rhymes- choose a few nursery rhymes to sing to your child.
