READING TIPS

Read every day and establish a routine

Let your child hold and explore the book

Read the same book multiple times

Use different voices and sounds while reading

Point to and name objects on the page

READ ALOUD

Before Reading- Take a picture walk through the book then ask your child what they think the story might be about.

During Reading- Point to the words as you read so your child can follow along with you.

After Reading- Go back through the story and ask your child what types of animals lived at the zoo.

BOOK ACTIVITIES

- Ask your child to draw a picture of their favorite zoo animal from the book
- Goodnight parade- You and your child are going to act like your favorite zoo animal and make a goodnight parade like the one in the story. Try to get other household members to join in! You can also use stuffed animals.
