AMENDMENT #10

MARSHALL UNIVERSITY

AND

SODEXO AMERICA, LLC

THIS AMENDMENT #10, dated April 3, 2024, is between MARSHALL UNIVERSITY (“University”) and SODEXO AMERICA, LLC (“Vendor”).

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, University and Vendor entered into that certain Contract # MU20DINING effective August 16, 2019, as amended (“Agreement”), whereby Vendor manages and operates the University's Food Services operation in Huntington, West Virginia;

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to further amend the aforesaid Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises herein contained and for other good and valuable consideration, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Effective March 1, 2024, the Parties acknowledge and agree that Sodexo shall provide a new baseball stadium located at Jack Cook Field, 1 Jack Cook Way, Huntington, West Virginia 25703. In consideration therefore, Section 4.11 is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

“4.11 Compliance with Laws, Policies & Procedures. To the extent applicable to the Services, Vendor shall fully comply with all federal, state, local, and University laws, rules, regulations, ordinances, policies and licenses, including applicable building policies and procedures. Vendor shall be solely responsible for ensuring that any recommendations made in connection with the Services comply with all applicable federal, state, local and University laws, rules, regulations, policies and procedures. Vendor shall be responsible to obtain and maintain any necessary liquor licenses and permits for the Joan C. Edwards Stadium and the Hoops Family Field at the Veterans Memorial Soccer Complex and in the Student Center. Vendor shall have the exclusive right to sell and serve alcoholic beverages at the following locations:

Joan C. Edwards Stadium: One John Marshall Drive, Huntington, West Virginia 25755

Student Center: 1W27 Memorial Student Center, One John Marshall Drive, Huntington, West Virginia 25755

Hoops Family Field at Veterans Memorial Soccer Complex: 2598 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Huntington, West Virginia 25703

Cam Henderson Arena: 1917 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Huntington, West Virginia 25703

Dot Hicks Field: 2202 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Huntington, West Virginia 25703

Drinko Coffee Shop: 410 Hal Greer Boulevard, Huntington, West Virginia 25755

Brad D Smith Center for Business and Innovation: 1425 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Huntington, West Virginia 25701

Jack Cook Field: 1 Jack Cook Way, Huntington, West Virginia 25703

Vendor shall adhere to all applicable federal, state, local laws and regulations regarding the service of alcoholic beverages. Vendor shall not be obligated to serve alcoholic beverages to any person believed by any employee of Vendor to be under the legal age to consume alcohol, and shall have the right, as a condition of the serving of any alcoholic beverage, to require proof of age from any person requesting such service. Further, Vendor shall have the right to refuse service of alcoholic beverages to any person who its employees believe to be intoxicated or otherwise impaired. University shall be responsible to provide security, as necessary, during the service of alcohol.”

2. Effective January 1, 2024, Section 13 is amended to reflect a change of both the first and second addresses for Notices to Vendor as follows:

The following paragraph is added to the end of Section 13 Notices, as follows:

“With respect to any written notice or communication transmitted by the Client to Vendor’s Law Department in accordance with this Section 13, the Client may, as an additional notification, use the email address set forth herein. Email notification shall not be used as an alternative to written notice served personally, delivered by courier or a nationally recognized overnight delivery service, or sent by United States certified mail, postage prepaid with return receipt requested.”

3. All capitalized terms used herein shall have the same meanings set forth in the Agreement unless otherwise expressly provided in this Amendment.



AMENDMENT #11

MARSHALL UNIVERSITY

AND

SODEXO AMERICA, LLC

THIS AMENDMENT #11, dated October 23, 2024, is between MARSHALL UNIVERSITY ("University") and SODEXO AMERICA, LLC ("Vendor").

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, University and Vendor entered into that certain Contract # MU20DINING effective August 16, 2019, as amended ("Agreement"), whereby Vendor manages and operates the University's Food Services operation in Huntington, West Virginia;

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to further amend the aforesaid Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises herein contained and for other good and valuable consideration, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Section 2, Term, is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

"2. Term. The effective date of this Agreement will be the fully executed signature date. The term of this Agreement will begin on August 16, 2024, ("Commencement Date") and end on August 15, 2025. At the end of the term, this Agreement will be evaluated. If the parties agree that it is a mutually beneficial relationship, the Agreement may be extended in writing for up to ten (10) additional one (1) year periods. Time is of the essence in this Agreement. University and Vendor agree to participate in Expectations Sessions, in accordance with Exhibit E, throughout the term of this Agreement with a minimum of one (1) per contract year."

2. The parties have agreed that any unused Investment funds provided to the University under Exhibit A, Section E shall be reallocated to support the Food Service operations, including the Chick-Fil-A renovations during the summer of 2026, with any other remaining Investment funds upon mutual agreement of the parties. All Investment funds reallocated shall continue to be amortized and have buyback protections as reflected under Exhibit A, Section E.

3. University is converting the John Marshall Dining Room into a training table for its athletes. University has requested, and Vendor has agreed, to operate a new training table as a one (1) year pilot program. The parties have reviewed the pilot program after the initial year of operations and has determined that the training table should continue.

Therefore, commencing August 21, 2024, Exhibit A, Financial Arrangements, Subsection I is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

"1. Training Table. Vendor shall operate a training table for University athletes ("Training Table") located at One John Marshall Drive, Huntington, West Virginia 25755 on a cost reimbursable basis. The following shall apply to the Training Table operations:

1. Definitions.

1.1 Training Table Deficit. The excess of the total of Training Table Operating Expenses and Management Fee over Training Table Net Sales.

1.2 Training Table Expendable Equipment. Any expendable item used in the preparation and service of meals such as pots, pans, and cooking and serving utensils used in the Training Table.

1.3 Training Table General Support Services Allowance. An allowance for Vendor overhead for (i) the supervision of and technical support for Vendor employees by executives not assigned to the Services operation, and (ii) general support provided by Vendor's accounting, tax and internal audit departments, and (iii) training and development, quality review, and research and development.

1.4 Training Table Gross Sales. All sales of food, beverages, goods, merchandise and services in the Training Table, including sales taxes.

1.5 Training Table Net Sales. Training Table Gross Sales excluding sales and other applicable taxes.

1.6 Training Table Operating Expenses. As defined under Section 2.1 below.

1.7 Training Table Surplus. The excess of Training Table Net Sales over the total of Training Table Operating Expenses and Management Fee.

2. Financial Arrangement.

2.1 Management of Operation. Commencing on August 19, 2024, the following financial arrangements shall be in effect for the Training Table:

A. Vendor shall collect and deposit any Training Table Gross Sales from the Training Table operations. Vendor shall pay Training Table Operating Expenses in connection with the Training Table operations. Any Training Table Surplus or Training Table Deficit from the Training Table operations shall be for University's account.

B. Training Table Operating Expenses shall be defined as all costs, Charges and expenses incurred in connection with the Training Table operations including, but not limited to, the following:

1. The invoiced amounts to Vendor for goods and services [sold], including food, beverages, merchandise, cleaning products, equipment, supplies, and other contracted services, plus a Charge for procurement services equal to six tenths percent (.6%) of such invoiced amounts;

2. Vendor's labor, including salaries (and bonuses, if any), wages, taxes, health benefits, relocation expenses, payroll processing, retirement plans, and the cost of administering such plans and services;

3. A General Support Services Allowance equal to four and one-half percent (4.5%) of Training Table Operating Expenses described in Subsections 1, 2, and 4; and

4. Other costs, Charges and expenses, including, but not limited to, amortization or depreciation of equipment, any Investment made pursuant to the terms of this Agreement, Charges for workers' compensation and general liability insurance based on the average manual rates for such insurance in the geographic area of the Premises, other insurance related to the Training Table provided herein, cost of licenses, permits and certifications, information systems, software and software maintenance, armored car services, fees and expenses associated with accepting and processing credit and debit card sales, bank service fees (net of any interest) for depositing receipts from the Training Table operations, third party recruitment and placement fees, marketing and promotional or proprietary materials, uniforms and linen, flowers, decorations, decor, signage, overnight delivery, if necessary, Smallwares, Training Table Expendable Equipment, minor equipment, repair and maintenance of Vendor-supplied equipment, sales, use and other taxes related to the Training Table operations (other than taxes collected and remitted by Vendor to a taxing authority), training expenses (including travel) for employees assigned to the Training Table operations, criminal background investigations and drug screenings for Vendor's employees assigned to the Training Table operations at the Premises, fees and expenses associated with the installation, implementation and ongoing operation of Branded Concepts operated by Vendor, including royalty payments payable to franchisors and licensors, a Charge for marketing support and culinary services equal to three tenths percent (.3%) of Training Table Net Sales, commissions paid, electronic meal program identification system supplies, and other items and contracted services purchased on behalf of the Training Table operations.

C. University shall pay Vendor a "Management Fee" equal to three percent (3%) of Operating Expenses described in Subsections 1, 2 and 4.

D. Many of Vendor's manufacturers, suppliers and distributors provide rebates, allowances, and other payments to Vendor based on Vendor's purchasing commitments, aggregate growth incentives and other factors. Prompt payment discounts and all rebates, allowances and other payments obtained from manufacturers, suppliers and distributors, shall be retained by Vendor.

2.2 Training Table Door Prices. Door prices shall be as follows:

Full Buffet	\$19.00, plus tax, if applicable
Soup and Salad	\$10.99, plus tax, if applicable

Student athletes on a University fully funded scholarship who has a 14 meals per week meal plan will swipe into the Training Table and have a meal deducted, receiving a Four Dollar (\$4.00) Harless credit, and athletics will be billed Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per swipe. Student athletes on the 10 meals per week or the 175 meals per semester meal plans, as well as student athletes not on any meal plan, will check in at the register and athletes will be billed the Nineteen Dollar (\$19.00) door rate. Soup and Salad will only be offered to anyone not on a meal plan.

Non-student athletes on an existing Resident Dining Meal Plan defined

under Exhibit B, Subsection A.1, shall receive a Two Dollar (\$2.00) discount off the above full buffet door price only, and shall pay as entry into the Training Table either (i) using a meal swipe plus Ten Dining Dollars (\$10.00), or (ii) Seventeen Dining Dollar (\$17.00). The meal swipe for the meal period used at the Training Table cannot be used for the same meal period in Harless Dining Hall.

2.3 Mandatory Athletes on Meal Plans. University has agreed to maintain a required minimum number of athletes on Meal Plans A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H or I, as defined under Exhibit B, Subsection A.1, purchased by the University for scholarship athletes or meal plans purchased individually by non-scholarship student athletes, as follows:

<u>Academic Semester</u>	<u>Required Athletes on Meal Plans A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I</u>
Fall 2024 semester	161 athlete participants
Spring 2025 semester	150 athlete participants

University shall be invoiced for the actual number of athlete meal plan participants on Meal Plans A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H or I, or the required minimum number of athlete meal plan participants, whichever is greater, based on the average rate of Meal Plans A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, and I, defined under Exhibit B, Subsection B, per semester.

3. Training Table Billing. No later than fifteen (15) days after the end of each month, Vendor shall submit to University an invoice for Training Table Operating Expenses and Management Fee in excess of Training Table Net Sales retained by Vendor for the applicable period. Payment shall be due within thirty (30) days after date of invoice. No later than thirty (30) days after the end of each week, Vendor shall pay to University University's share of Training Table Surplus, if any.

4. Hours of Operations. The Training Table hours of operations shall be Monday through Thursday, between the hours of 7:30am to 2:00pm, and will follow the board days calendar unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties.

5. Training Table Inventories of Food, Beverages, Goods and Supplies. Vendor shall purchase the inventory of food, beverages, goods, merchandise and supplies for the Training Table, the Charges for which shall be charged as Training Table Operating Expenses as provided in Section 2.1 above. Such inventory shall be owned by University. Vendor and University shall jointly inventory all food, beverages and supplies and establish a value based on University's purchase price so that Vendor can provide accurate usage figures to University.

4. Exhibit B, Meal Plans and Rates, Retail Operations, Guest Meals, Preseason, Summer Camp and Conferences, Subsection B is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

"B. Dining Program Rates. The following dining rates shall be in effect for the 2024-2025 academic year as follows:

Meal Plan A – 10 meals \$500 Flex	\$14.99 per person, per day
Meal Plan B – 10 meals \$700 Flex	\$16.38 per person, per day
Meal Plan C – 10 meals \$935 Flex	\$17.33 per person, per day
Meal Plan D – 14 meals \$500 Flex	\$17.33 per person, per day
Meal Plan E – 14 meals \$700 Flex	\$18.73 per person, per day



Meal Plan F – 14 meals \$935 Flex	\$19.67 per person, per day
Meal Plan G – 175 meals \$500 Flex	\$16.03 per person, per day
Meal Plan H – 175 meals \$700 Flex	\$17.50 per person, per day
Meal Plan I – 175 meals \$935 Flex	\$19.32 per person, per day
Meal Plan J – 30 melas \$200 Flex	\$327.30 per person, per plan sold
Meal Plan K – 50 meals \$100 Flex	\$351.58 per person, per plan sold
Meal Plan L – 50 meals \$350 Flex	\$601.58 per person, per plan sold
Meal Plan M – 50 meals \$600 Flex	\$851.85 per person, per plan sold

Rates for the above meal plans are based on a required minimum of two hundred fourteen (214) meal plan days for each academic year.

Rates for the above Meal Plans include the Flex associated with each Plan.”

5. Exhibit B, Subsection C, Retail Program, Subsection 1, Branded Concepts, letter e, is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

“e. Vendor shall operate or cause to be operated the following Branded Concepts with the applicable fees applied as operating expenses:

1. Chick Fil A
2. Steak N Shake
3. Mein Bowl
4. Bison Bites & More
5. LaFamiglia
6. Starbucks fully licensed store
7. Simply To Go”

6. Exhibit B, Subsection E, is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

“E. Guest Meals in Resident Dining Facilities. Prices for guest meals purchased in resident dining facilities shall be as follows:

Breakfast	\$ 8.72, plus tax, if applicable
Lunch	\$10.76, plus tax, if applicable
Dinner	\$12.67, plus tax, if applicable
Brunch	\$10.76, plus tax, if applicable”

7. Exhibit B, Meal Plans and Rates, Retail Operations, Guest Meals, Preseason, Summer Camp and Conferences, Subsection G is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

“G. Preseason Meals. Preseason meals for athletic teams shall be charged to University as follows:

1. A period of one (1) hour and fifteen (15) minutes will be allotted for service of athletic training table meals. Additional hours of service will be charged to University at a rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per additional hour. Additionally, the preseason per athletic meals for the athletic department sports program will not exceed the following prices:

Breakfast: \$17.00

Lunch	\$19.50
Dinner	\$22.00

2. Training table meals throughout football season. Vendor may be requested to furnish training table meals in the Big Green Room at Joan C. Edwards Stadium. If requested:

- Coaches, staff and players not participating in a meal plan will be billed per meal at the prevailing guest meal rate, in accordance with Exhibit B, Section E above.
- A roster of players (along with MU ID number) on meal plans as well as any other eligible participants must be provided prior to any meals being served.
- Any cancellations must be made no later than twenty four (24) hours in advance.
- Paper products will be purchased by Vendor and billed in bulk to the University's Athletic Department. Copies of invoices for purchase of these products attached to the purchase order will be sent to the University's Athletic Department for auditing purposes.

Evening Meals (labor allotted 1.5 hours)	\$307.15
Training Table (additional Hours over 1.5)	\$ 51.50

When Breakfast includes an omelet station the price will be Eighteen and 75/100 Dollars (\$18.75) per athletic meal. An additional charge of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) would apply for chef services for the omelet station.”

8. Exhibit B, Meal Plans and Rates, Retail Operations, Guest Meals, Preseason, Summer Camp and Conferences, Subsection J is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

“J. Summer Meal Plans and Rates. The following meal plans selected by the University shall be available to patrons during the Summer 2024:

Summer 2024 Meal Plans

- Meal Plan N – 30 meals per semester; plus \$200 Flex per semester
- Meal Plan O – 50 meals per semester; plus \$100 Flex per semester
- Meal Plan Q – 19 meals per week

Summer 2024 Meal Plan Rates

Meal Plan N	\$327.30 per person, per plan sold
Meal Plan O	\$351.58 per person, per plan sold
Meal Plan Q	\$16.32 per person, per day

Unused block meals and Flex shall expire at the end of the summer semester and shall be for Vendor's account.

University grants Vendor the exclusive right to provide University with meals related to meal plans, debit card points and flex points for University to resell to its students, faculty and staff at a specified rate per meal or daily rate.”

9. Exhibit B, Meal Plans and Rates, Retail Operations, Guest Meals, Preseason, Summer Camp and Conferences, Subsection I is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

“I. Student Meal Sharing Program. Vendor and University desire to work

together to create a "Student Meal Sharing Program" ("Program") at University. Notwithstanding the foregoing, students who have purchased meal plans pursuant to the Resident Dining Program, as described herein, may donate meals for use by "students in-need" as set forth below:

- a. All Meal Plans. Students who have purchased any meal plan may donate up to four (4) of their regular meals, per semester, to the Program. Upon donation to the Program, the student's regular meals will be reduced by the number of donated meals.
- b. Students In-Need Food Bank. The donated meals will be placed in a pool or bank of meals that may be used by "students in-need".
- c. Students In-Need. Students In-Need will be identified solely by the University.
- d. Donated Meals Exhausted. Should the number of donated meals be exhausted in any given semester, there will be no further obligation on the part of either party to provide additional meals.
- e. Donated Meals Expiration. All donations will expire at the end of the semester in which they were donated.
- f. University reserves the right to name or rename the Student Meal Sharing Program without the need to modify this Agreement.
- g. University will provide the necessary technology support and database information for the implementation and operation of the Program."

10. All capitalized terms used herein shall have the same meanings set forth in the Agreement unless otherwise expressly provided in this Amendment.

11. Unless otherwise stated herein, this Amendment #11 is effective August 14, 2024, and thereafter, unless amended. All other terms and conditions contained in the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect, except by necessary implication.



# PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

**CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS:** Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(i), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

**ALL CONTRACTS:** Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

**EXCEPTION:** The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

**DEFINITIONS:**

**"Debt"** means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

**"Employer default"** means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

**"Related party"** means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

**AFFIRMATION:** By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (W. Va. Code §61-2-3) that: (1) for construction contracts, the vendor is not in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, and (2) for all other contracts, that neither vendor nor any related party owe a debt as defined above and that neither vendor nor any related party are in employer default as defined above, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.
